Our colleagues at the University of Aveiro are also involved in another interesting air quality modelling project: Life Index-AIR. Their aim is to calculate population exposure and dose to Air Particulate Matter chemical compounds, to quantify the health impacts related to this exposure and to identify actions to improve air quality that have an impact in the health and well-being of the population. In the next 3 years the LIFE Index-Air tool will be implemented in Lisbon, Porto, Athens, Kuopio and Treviso. Find out more in their [project newsletter](#).
